BOARDING AGREEMENT

Dear Pet Owner,

We are pleased that you have chosen our hospital to be “home” for your pet while you are away.

To ensure the highest quality care and health standards at our pet motel, we require that the following guidelines be met:

All pets must have current vaccinations and stool exam.

Dogs must have Rabies, Distemper, and Bordatella vaccines.

Cats must have Rabies and Distemper vaccines. We recommend Leukemia vaccinations, but they are not required for boarding.

All animals entering the motel must be up to date on vaccinations and free of external parasites (fleas, ticks, etc.) or they will be treated upon entry at the owner’s expense.

Please note that a “Bath” is required of any pet either a) entering with fleas or b) prior to discharge if the pet has boarded with us for more than three days.

At our pet motel, your pet is like one of our own. Should a problem arise in your absence, we will perform any necessary treatments to ensure your pet’s good health. Please note that you will be responsible for all expenses of extra veterinary care. If tranquilization is necessary for either treatment or the handling of the pet, Animal Medical Center has the permission to administer such medication.

If the owner or designated agent neglects to call or pick up the pet within 5 days of the release date stated above, Animal Medical Center can assume that the pet has been abandoned and is hereby authorized to deliver the pet(s) to the Pinellas County Animal Control. The Animal Medical Center will no longer be responsible for the pet(s).

Full payment is required upon the pet(s) release. Pets are released only during regular Medical Center hours.

Please note: At your request, while your pet(s) is/are boarding, Dr. Brancato can implant a permanent identification marker, known as a “Microchip”. Please see the receptionist for details.
