COVID-19 Announcement

Pinellas County officials have issued a “safer at home” directive to help prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus by social distancing. The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reports the virus is spread human to human by droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or speaks. The World Health Organization (WHO), at this time, does not believe pets can transmit COVID-19.

To implement these guidelines we are making adjustments to our hospital policies.

1. Call 727-531-2457 to schedule a medical appointment or boarding
2. All scheduled appointments should call 727-531-2457 upon arrival. Stay in your car. For safety reasons, all dogs need to be leashed and cats must be transported in a carrier. Let us know if you need to borrow one.
3. Check in and history will be done via phone at the time you arrive.
4. A member of our staff will then meet you at curbside and bring your pet in to the hospital for examination
5. Dr. Brancato will call you from the hospital to discuss the examination and treatment. You need to have your cell phone available.
6. Please wait in your car until your pet is returned to you.
7. Future appointments and payment will be processed at curbside or by cell phone before leaving
8. For medication, and food refills call 727-531-2457

When your requests have been completed we will notify you and take payment by phone.
